GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

1. Admission to various programmes in Central University of Gujarat shall be subject to applicants fulfilling all the eligibility criteria as mentioned on the University website. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that s/he fulfils the eligibility criteria for a particular programme where s/he is an applicant.
2. Central University of Gujarat reserves the right to add or drop any academic programme at any stage without citing any reason for the same. The University also reserves the right to change the number of seats in the research programmes offered for admissions.
3. A candidate appearing for admissions at CUG through CUCET -2020 must have appeared in the final examination of the qualifying degree and declared passed with minimum required percentage as per the eligibility criteria mentioned for the said programme. Applicants awaiting result in the qualifying examination may apply, however, their admission shall be subject to minimum eligibility marks in the qualifying examination.
4. The candidates whose qualifying examination results are not declared at the time of admission will be given provisional admission at CUG and they need to submit the marks sheet of the qualifying examination to the admission department latest by 31st July 2020. If such candidates fail to secure the required percentage of marks in their qualifying examination or fail in the said examination their admission would automatically stand cancelled.
5. All the eligible candidates must appear in the entrance test at the respective test centre(s) on their own and according to the schedule.
6. Regarding dates of counselling for UG/PG and Research programmes, Admission Merit list, Enrollment Form, Mode of Fee Payment, verification of documents and any other admission related information will be updated on the CUG website from time to time. **All candidates are advised to visit University website regularly for admission related information and updates.**
7. During admission, if a candidate is not able to provide some of the necessary documents/certificates except the qualifying examination marks sheet (which is mandatory for admission), her/his admission shall be considered provisional. The last date of submission of any of the pending documents/certificates is 30th September 2020 failing which the admission of the student shall be liable to be cancelled.



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8. If any candidate's certificates including degree certificate, birth certificate, caste or income certificates are found to be fake/fabricated/falsified at any point of time during or after the course of study, the admission of such a student shall be cancelled or if degree has been awarded, it will be declared null and void.
9. The selected candidates shall be required to pay requisite fee of the programme in which s/he has been offered admission. In case, if any student fails to deposit fees within the stipulated period, his/her offer for admission shall stand cancelled and other candidates from the waiting list will be considered for the admission purely on merit basis.
10. Changes in fee structure will be subject to administrative decision of the University.
11. All the admitted students shall have to submit Migration/Transfer Certificate from their respective previous University/College/School positively before 30th September 2020.
12. In case, a student leaves the programme in the middle of the semester and cancels her/his admission, the fee shall be refunded as applicable under the rules.
13. Various rules and regulations regarding admission and teaching-cum-evaluation as prescribed in the relevant ordinances of the University, and also announced from time to time by the University are to be strictly adhered to and followed by all the students. Any violation will attract disciplinary action.
14. As per the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, ragging of any kind is prohibited within and outside the premises of the University. Any student found guilty of involved in ragging and/or abetting ragging is liable to be punished appropriately as per rules of the University/UGC guidelines.
15. The University holds the right to cancel the application and admission of any candidate for wrongful submission of facts pertaining to qualification, reservation and/or any other matters.
16. The information regarding admission may be changed as per administrative decisions in the future. Course contents may be revised as per decisions of the relevant statutory bodies of CUG.
17. All disputes shall be subject to Gujarat High Court Jurisdiction only.
