#### Circular No.04/2017-18

As you are aware that the Central Universities are Statutory Autonomous Organizations established under an Act of Parliament and governed by their own Act, Statutes/Ordinances/Regulations framed there-under.

All administrative and academic decisions are taken by the University with the approval of its Statutory Bodies, such as Executive Council, Academic Council and Court etc. Every new Statute or addition to the Statute or any amendment or repeal of a Statute shall require the assent of the Hon'ble Visitor. A new Statute, or any amendment or repealing an existing Statute shall have no validity unless it has been assented by the Visitor.

Hence, all the Deans, Chairpersons, Coordinators and Teachers of the Schools and Centres of the University are advised to abide by Statute 40 so far as the nomenclature of Schools and Centres are concerned. Assented Nomenclature of Schools and Centres, as notified in the Gazette of India as per Statute- 40 is enclosed herewith for reference and compliance. This applies to all Schools and Centres except Centre for Nano Science and Centre for Library and Information Science which are under active consideration for upgradation as Schools through amendment of Statute 40.

- vii. Six Associate Professors, by rotation, adequately representing different Schools of Studies, according to seniority nominated by the Vice Chancellor
- viii. Six Assistant Professors, by rotation, adequately representing different Schools of Studies, according to seniority nominated by the Vice Chancellor
- ix. Dean of Students' Welfare
- x. Librarian
- xi. One Proctor by rotation according to seniority
- xii. One Provost by rotation according to seniority
- xiii. One Warden by rotation according to seniority
- xiv. Four persons not in the service of the University, co-opted by the Academic Council for their special knowledge
- xv. Two Members of the Court, when constituted, elected from amongst the elected members, none of whom shall be an employee or student of the University or an institution recognized by or associated with the University.
- xvi. Two students' representatives, to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor on merit basis, from members of the Student Council of University, on rotation basis. Such members hall not have the right to be present at the meeting of the Academic Council when it takes up for consideration any of the following subjects:
  - (a) Faculty positions, recruitment, conditions of service and academic freedom;
  - (b) Actual processes of evaluating academic performance and merit of students.
- xvii. The following representatives:
  - One of Scheduled Castes
  - · One of Scheduled Tribe
  - One of Other Backward Classes
  - · One of Minorities
  - One of Women; and
  - · One of the Differently Abled

shall be nominated by the Vice Chancellor as members from the teachers of the University or other Central/State Universities,
